- Led the development and first engineer of a full-stack platform that automated large-scale video compositing, transforming a manual engineering task into a self-service tool used by Campaign Managers. This system, built with a Next.js (React) front-end, Micronaut (Kotlin) API, and AWS infrastructure defined in CDK, dramatically increased production capacity and opened a new integrated ads business line.
- Led the development and ownership of a core ad-tech platform suite, enabling the orchestration of ingestion, processing, and analysis of video content from publisher feeds.
- **Saved tens of thousands of dollars per month** by creating a scalable system which moved unused, large video files to the Glacier Deep Archive storage class in S3.

- Saved the SEO team ~\$30k/month by replacing a paid Link Equity service with an in-house tool. The system used a Node.js Lambda function and a Laravel backend to provide real-time, data-driven recommendations, significantly improving efficiency and reducing costs.
- **Built a programmatic ad tool in Laravel** that automatically generated multiple headline, copy, and photo bundles for Facebook ads. The system tested and scheduled the highest-performing versions, successfully increasing article click-through rates.
- **Developed and launched The Dad mobile application** using React Native, a Laravel API, and Firebase for notifications, reaching 15,000 users and providing daily content.
- **Mentored a small team**, managed the hiring process, and implemented continuous integration and continuous deployment (CI/CD) pipelines on AWS.
